Table of Clinical Audit Activities

Category	Example Activities	Credits
Clinical Audit <i>Audit activities should be focused on the practice of the practitioner and not on the processes.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Measurement of individual compliance with guidelines protocols (one per year)- Double reading- Simulator training (ACLS, etc)- Skills analysis- Department/practice audit- Directly Observed Procedures (DOPS)- Individual Practice review- Evaluation of individual risk incidents/complaints- Patient satisfaction- Self assessment- Peer review- Work Site Visits (Occupational Medicine)	Minimum 1 audit per year. Recommended that practitioners spend 1 hour per month on audit activity
